It is **essential** that all Rugby League team organisers interested in registering a team to compete at the 2016 Pan Pacific Masters Games read this guide.

Additional Information	The competition format will be 13-a-side.
	 There is no limit for how many players that can be registered in a team. However, a maximum 20 players can be listed on the team sheet each game. Players will need to play a minimum number of pool games to qualify for the finals. The 35+ Competitive division will be conducted under International Rugby League rules with slight modifications (Pan Pacific Masters Games by-laws) to make it safer for masters participants. The 35+ Social division will be conducted under International Masters Rugby League rules (same as ARL Masters event). This is where players 45-49 can wear red shorts and players 50+ can wear yellow shorts with
	 45-49 can wear red shorts and players 504 can wear years with different rules applying to these players. Pan Pacific Masters Games by-laws will also apply to this division. The competition is presented by Mudgeeraba Redbacks Junior Rugby League Club.

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2) Overview

In order to secure your team's place in the 2016 Pan Pacific Masters Games Rugby League competition team organisers must:

- i) Select team division
- ii) Create a team name and code
- iii) Register and pay for at least one player or Non-Playing Official that is attached to the team.

Registrations will open on Thursday 5 November 2015 at www.mastersgames.com.au.

3) <u>Securing your team's position</u>

Once you have decided that you would like to enter a team in the Pan Pacific Masters Games your first job is to drum up some interest from your fellow players. As previously mentioned only one player or Non-Playing Official needs to be registered to secure the team. However, multiple players and Non-Playing Officials can be registered at the same time. If you are planning on registering multiple players or Non-Playing Officials you will then need to collect payment and some personal and contact details from each player.

It will take some time to register multiple people and you will *not* be able to save and complete at a later time. In addition to plenty of time, you will also require a reliable computer and internet connection.

Registration Fees

There are two types of Fees:

1. Games Fee - Each participant is required to pay the Games Fee. Which fee depends on whether they are a player, non-playing official, or a supporter:

Competitors: **\$110 per person*** Non-Playing Officials: **\$80 per person*** Supporters: **\$75 per person***

2. Sport Fee - Only players are required to pay the sport fee:

Rugby League Sport Fee: \$85 per player per team

Notes:

- *A \$5 'fusesport Service Fee' is payable per entrant. The service fee is payable regardless of entry type and charged only once per entrant. This fee incorporates charges from the software technology provider, secure payment gateway fees and imposed merchant fees.
- ii) A \$20 Late Fee will be incurred on the Competitor Games Fee for entries received after 31 August, 2016.
- iii) The Games Fee is only paid <u>once</u> per person regardless of how many sports they enter.
- iv) The Competitor Games Fee is for anyone playing in a sport.
- v) The Non-Playing Official Games Fee is team managers, umpires, scorers, coaches or officials who will not be playing but still want to be officially linked to the team and be eligible for a medal should the team place first, second or third.

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- vi) The Supporter Games Fee is for family or friends of a player who would like to attend the nightly entertainment.
- vii) You will only be able to create and manage teams if you are registered as a Competitor or Non-Playing Official.
- viii) Only Visa or MasterCard will be accepted. AMEX and Diners Club will not be accepted.

The above fees are to be multiplied by the number of players and Non-Playing Official that you are registering at the one time to determine the full amount payable.

Please note you will require a credit card with a limit that covers the full amount required.

Team creation

As the team manager, during the registration process you will need to create your team. To do so, you will need to nominate the division/age group, team code and team name of your team. Once you have registered the team you can then pass on the team name, code and division to any additional players or Non-Playing Officials so they can register as an individual in the team.
