PAN PACIFIC MASTERS GAMES - BASKETBALL COMPETITION BY-LAWS

Timings:-

- I. 2 x 18 minute halves (running clock)
- II. 3 minutes warm-up
- III. 3 minutes half time
- IV. No time outs in the last minute of the first half
- V. The clock stops on all whistles and made baskets during the last 2 minutes of the second half only.
- VI. If the scores are tied at the end of regular playing time extra time will be played in **FINALS ONLY** (Note - 3 minutes overtime period, with a one minute break between regular time and extra periods will be taken)

Points:-

Win – 3 Points
Draw – 2 Points
Loss – 1 Point
Forfeit – 0 Points

Scorebench Duties:-

Each team must supply one bench official for the game immediately following their game. WHERE THIS DOES NOT OCCUR, THE OFFENDING TEAM WILL LOSE POINTS FOR THEIR GAME (WILL BE RECORDED AS 0-20 FORFEIT).

Players:-

- I. Teams can nominate a maximum of 12 players
- II. Players can only play down an age group
- III. Players are not permitted to play in more than one team in the same age group i.e:40+ Div1/40+Div2. The result of this occurring will be a forfeited game for the second team he/she played for.
- IV. Players may play in more than one age category i.e. 50+ & 45+
- V. Players must play a minimum of two games for each team they are registered with to qualify for finals.
- VI. All medal winning teams are provided a medal for each registered participant in that team.
