



2014 PPMG FAQ - Trivia



Play It, Live It, Love It!

I've only ever played trivia socially. Should I still nominate?

Yes. The question sets have been designed to be engaging and enjoyable for all levels of play. The majority of questions will be of low to moderate difficulty, with a being more challenging. The team event is the recommended option for social players.

I don't live in the Asia-Pacific region. Can I still enter?

Yes. The whole world is invited.

What is the event format?

There will be four qualifying rounds, two on Thursday 6th November and two on Friday 7th November. The final will be on Saturday 8th November.

How do I qualify for the final?

The top place-getters in each qualifying round (both individual and team) automatically qualify for the final. In addition, those with the highest aggregate scores over the four qualifying rounds will also qualify.

How many individuals / teams will qualify for the final?

That will be determined once nominations close.

Do points from the qualifying rounds carry over to the final round?

No. All finalists will start from zero.

I am playing in another sport. What do I do if there is a clash?

Participants can attend any or all of the qualifying rounds for trivia, though obviously the more rounds one plays the greater the opportunities of qualifying for the final. There are no alternative arrangements available should the trivia final round clash with another event.

I didn't qualify for the final but can I please play along?

Yes. All participants may play in the final, but only those who qualified will receive official scores and be eligible for medals.
