

2014 PPMG FAQ - Trivia



Play It, Live It, Love It!

I've only ever played trivia socially. Should I still nominate?

Yes. The question sets have been designed to be engaging and enjoyable for all levels of play. The majority of questions will be of low to moderate difficulty, with a minority being more challenging. See the <u>sample quiz</u> for examples. The team event is the recommended option for social players.

I don't live in the Asia-Pacific region. Can I still enter?

Yes. The whole world is invited.

What is the cost?

\$125.00. PPMG registration is \$100.00 and paid only once, no matter how many sports are played. It includes accreditation and an extensive social program. The trivia fee is an additional \$25.00. For a list of other sports, see the PPMG website.

When can I nominate?

Nominations open 7 May 2014.

What is the event format?

There will be four qualifying rounds, two on Thursday 6th November and two on Friday 7th November. The final will be on Saturday 8th November.

How do I qualify for the final?

The top place-getters in each qualifying round (both individual and team) automatically qualify for the final. In addition, those with the highest aggregate scores over the four qualifying rounds will also qualify.

How many individuals / teams will qualify for the final?

That will be determined once nominations close.

What is the team size?

Teams can have a maximum of three players.

Can I play in both the team and individual events?

No, participants can play as individuals or in teams but not both.

Can I be placed in a team?

Yes. If you would prefer to play in the team event but lack partners then register for the team event. When the PPMG website prompts you to list your team members' names, just enter "REQUIRED" and we'll allocate you to a team. Alternatively, you can post your availability to the PPMG Bulletin Board.

Do points from the qualifying rounds carry over to the final round?

No. All finalists will start from zero.

I am playing in another sport. Will that cause problems?

The trivia format and schedule have been specifically designed to facilitate participation in other sports. Participants can attend any or all of the qualifying rounds for trivia, though obviously the more rounds one plays the greater the opportunities of qualifying for the final. Unfortunately there are no alternative arrangements available should the trivia final clash with another event.

I didn't qualify for the final but can I please play along?

Yes. All participants may play in the final, but only those who qualified will receive official scores and be eligible for medals.
