



## 2016 PPMG FAQ - Trivia



### *Play It, Live It, Love It!*

#### **I've only ever played trivia socially. Should I still nominate?**

Yes. The question sets have been designed to be engaging and enjoyable for all levels of play. The questions will cover a full range of difficulty levels, from easy to challenging. Following feedback from the 2014 event there will be separate questions difficulty levels for the trivia and multisport divisions. Nevertheless, the team event is the recommended option for social players. Click to see a [sample quiz](#).

#### **Will I be up against expert quizzers?**

We expect some of Australia's best quizzers to participate, but only in the trivia division. Those playing another sport can nominate for the multisport division.

#### **I don't live in the Asia-Pacific region. Can I still enter?**

Yes. The whole world is invited.

#### **What is the cost?**

\$140.00 total. The JPPMG registration and fuseport fee of \$115.00 (by 31 August) and paid only once, no matter how many sports are played. It includes accreditation and an extensive social program. The trivia fee is an additional \$25.00. For a list of other sports, see the [JPPMG website](#).

#### **When can I nominate?**

Nominations are now open and will close on Wednesday, 9<sup>th</sup> November. [Nominate Now](#).

#### **What is the event format?**

There will be four qualifying rounds, three on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> November and one on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November. The final will be on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November.

#### **How do I qualify for the final?**

It depends on final numbers but it is anticipated that all participants will qualify for the final.

#### **What is the team size limit?**

Teams can have a minimum of three and a maximum of four players.

#### **Can I play in more than one event?**

No. Participants can play as an individual, in a pair, or in a team, but cannot participate in more than one event.

**Can I be placed in a team?**

Yes. If you would prefer to play in the team event but lack partners then register for the team event. When the PPMG website prompts you to list your team members' names, just enter "REQUIRED" and we'll allocate you to a team. Alternatively, you can post your availability to the [JPPMG Bulletin Board](#).

**Do points from the qualifying rounds carry over to the final round?**

No. All finalists will start from zero.

**I am playing in another sport. Will that cause problems?**

The trivia format and schedule have been specifically designed to facilitate participation in other sports. Participants can attend any or all of the qualifying rounds for trivia, as it is anticipated that all participants will qualify for the final. Unfortunately there are no alternative arrangements available should the trivia final clash with another event.
