NOTICE OF RACE

1 DATE, VENUE & ORGANISING AUTHORITY

- 1.1 The Paradise Point Sailing Club 2014 Pan Pacific Masters Games will be held on the Gold Coast Broadwater from Friday 31st October to Sunday 9th November, 2014
- 1.2 The Host Club, and the Organising Authority is The Paradise Point Sailing Club, The Esplanade, Paradise Point, Queensland 4216

2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by:
 - 2.1.1 The rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS),
 - 2.1.2 This Notice of Race,
 - 2.1.3 The Sailing Instructions

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Eligible competitors shall be a member of a National Authority affiliated Yacht/Sailing Club
- 3.2 The minimum age for competition is 30 Years as at 30 October 2014.
- 3.3 The regatta is open to all "off the beach" dingy, multi hull, windsurfer and Hansa classes.
- 3.4 Subject to entry numbers, boats may be allocated to divisions at the discretion of the Race Committee. Boats within a division will be scored based on class yardstick.
- 3.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it to Paradise Point Sailing Club at PO Box 479 Paradise Point 4216 by Thursday 16 October 2014. 4.2 Races are scheduled over 3 days for each class / division.

4.3 Up to 7 races will be conducted for each class or division. The number of races each day, and the times for subsequent warning signals will be at the discretion of the Race Committee.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the time of registration with the Paradise Point Sailing Club.

6 REGATTA SITE

7 RACING AREA

7.1 The racing area will be on Gold Coast Broadwater, to the east of the Paradise Point Sailing Club.

8 COURSES

8.1 The courses will be Windward Leeward, Triangular or Trapezoid courses as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SAFETY

9.1 Personal Buoyancy: All competitors shall wear Personal Floatation Devices at all times when afloat. Refer also to clause 2.2 of this Notice of Race.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

10.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This includes mobile phone.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be given out at the discretion of the Paradise Point Sailing Club.

12 MEDALS

12.1 First, Second and Third placegetters in each division and age group will be awarded medals.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
