2016 JUPITERS PAN PACIFIC MASTERS GAMES – Netball Planning Guide

It is **essential** that all Netball team organisers interested in registering a team to compete at the 2016 Jupiters Pan Pacific Masters Games read this guide.

1) Netball Information

Additional Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There will be a Team Manager's meeting on Friday 4 November at 5:30pm in the undercover area (bar area) at the venue. Finger food will be provided (drinks may be purchased). Game times may change depending on team numbers. It is recommended that each team consist of a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 12 players (in case of injury during the week).

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- All games will be 4 x 10 minute quarters.
- No grading games will be played – women’s team organisers should indicate an appropriate grade (A, B or C where relevant) when submitting their team entry. The organiser’s reserve the right to reallocate at their discretion.
- Teams will be placed in appropriate age groupings dependent on the total number of nominations received per age division.
- Competition rules will be provided in the Netball Sports program available only upon registration at the Games Village.
- Match balls will be supplied by organisers. Teams are required to bring their own practice balls.
- All team members must be wearing matching team uniforms. Women’s uniforms must be a dress or skirt and shirt. Women are not permitted to wear shorts. No skins or bike pants to be seen below hem line. All players must have uniforms below the pants line when walking.
- No special consideration is able to be given for game times. All teams must be available to compete at any time within the time schedule stated in Competition Times information listed above.
- The men’s and mixed competitions will only be conducted if more than six teams register in each of these divisions. Should a large number of registrations be received additional age groups may be added.
- All efforts will be made to ensure there are no scheduling clashes for participants playing in two teams (i.e. men’s and mixed teams or women’s and mixed teams not two women’s teams).
- Competition will be conducted under the All Australian Netball Association rules
- WEARING OF GLOVES – Please note that the All Australian Netball Association rules do not permit the wearing of gloves and permission to do so will not be granted.
- The competition is presented by Southport Carrara Netball Association.

Umpire Information

- All teams must provide at least one umpire for the competition. This individual is classified as a ‘non playing official’ and ONLY pays the Non-Playing Official fee.
- It is recommended that teams have a reserve umpire available. Should the umpire suffer an injury the team will still be expected to provide an umpire.
- A team umpire should NOT be a player as umpires may be rostered to umpire at the same time as their team plays.
- Umpires for the medal playoff rounds will be by invitation, based on their performance during the round robin.
- There will be no payments made to umpires by the organising committee.

2) Overview

In order to secure your team’s place in the 2016 Jupiters Pan Pacific Masters Games Netball competition team organisers must:

- Select team division
- Create a team name and code
- Register and pay for at least one player or Non-Playing Official that is attached to the team.

Registrations will open on **Thursday 5 November 2015** at www.mastersgames.com.au.

3) Securing your team's position

Once you have decided that you would like to enter a team in the Jupiters Pan Pacific Masters Games your first job is to drum up some interest from your fellow players. As previously mentioned only one player or Non-Playing Official needs to be registered to secure the team. However, multiple players and Non-Playing Officials can be registered at the same time. If you are planning on registering multiple players or Non-Playing Officials you will then need to collect payment and some personal and contact details from each player.

It will take some time to register multiple people and you will *not* be able to save and complete at a later time. In addition to plenty of time, you will also require a reliable computer and internet connection.

Registration Fees

There are two types of Fees:

1. *Games Fee* - Each participant is required to pay the Games Fee. Which fee depends on whether they are a player, non-playing official, or a supporter:

Competitors: **\$110 per person***

Non-Playing Officials: **\$80 per person***

Supporters: **\$75 per person***

2. *Sport Fee* - Only players are required to pay the sport fee:

Netball Sport Fee: **\$65 per player per team**

Notes:

- i) *A \$5 'fusesport Service Fee' is payable per entrant. The service fee is payable regardless of entry type and charged only once per entrant. This fee incorporates charges from the software technology provider, secure payment gateway fees and imposed merchant fees.
- ii) A \$20 Late Fee will be incurred on the Competitor Games Fee for entries received after 31 August, 2016.
- iii) The Games Fee is only paid once per person regardless of how many sports they enter.
- iv) The Competitor Games Fee is for anyone playing in a sport.
- v) The Non-Playing Official Games Fee is team managers, umpires, scorers, coaches or officials who will not be playing but still want to be officially linked to the team and be eligible for a medal should the team place first, second or third.
- vi) The Supporter Games Fee is for family or friends of a player who would like to attend the nightly entertainment.
- vii) You will only be able to create and manage teams if you are registered as a Competitor or Non-Playing Official.
- viii) Only Visa or MasterCard will be accepted. AMEX and Diners Club will not be accepted.

The above fees are to be multiplied by the number of players and Non-Playing Official that you are registering at the one time to determine the full amount payable. Please note you will require a credit card with a limit that covers the full amount required.

Team creation

As the team manager, during the registration process you will need to create your team. To do so, you will need to nominate the division/age group, team code and team name of your team. Once you have registered the team you can then pass on the team name, code and division to any additional players or Non-Playing Officials so they can register as an individual in the team.
