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2014 Pan Pacific Masters Games – Softball Team Planning Guide

It is **essential** that all Softball team organisers interested in registering a team to compete at the 2014 Pan Pacific Masters Games read this guide.

1) Softball Information

Competition Dates	Saturday 1 – Saturday 8 November, 2014
Competition Times	Saturday 1 November: 8am - 5pm Sunday 2 - Saturday 8 November: 8am - 5.30pm
Venue Details	Pizzey Park Sporting Complex, Sports Lane, MIAMI Robina Common, Ron Penhaligon Way, ROBINA
Age Requirements	Minimum age for competition is 35yrs Age is determined as at 1 November 2014 by the youngest player in the team.
Sport Fee	\$95 per player per team
Games Fee	Competitors \$100 (\$20 late fee applies after 3 September, 2014) Non-Playing Officials \$75
Entries Close Date	Teams must have a minimum of 10 players entered by Friday 12 September 2014. Individuals can still register into existing teams, however, after Friday 3 October 2014 their names will not be included in the softball sports program. Due to group capacity entry is limited to the first 100 teams to register.
Divisions	Division 1 35+ (Men & Women) - A-Grade, B-Grade, C-Grade, D-Grade and E-Grade Division 2 45+ (Men & Women) - A-Grade, B-Grade and C-Grade

Additional Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each team is required to register and make full payment for a minimum of 6 players. Each team will need to have 10 players registered by Friday 12 September in order to be included in the competition draw. Players may only play for one team. Each team is required to provide an accredited umpire. Additional 'Non-Playing Officials' (e.g. manager, coach, scorer) who wish to be included in the official team list and be eligible for a medal must register as a Non-Playing Official. The first section of competition (approximately two (2) days) will be used as a grading round. After this teams will be placed into their medal divisions. Every effort will be made to place into competitive divisions. Grades may be amalgamated at the softball organiser's discretion depending on the number of entries received in each grade. While not compulsory, shirt numbers are preferred. Number can appear on

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	<p>either the sleeve or the back of playing shirts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Close of entry date will be strictly adhered to due to limitation of team numbers. • First day draws will be available on the Games website one week prior to the start of Games. Participants will receive a full draw upon registration at the Games Village. • Competition will be conducted under the official Softball Australia rules and Gold Coast Softball Association ground rules. • The competition is presented by Gold Coast Softball and is sanctioned by the Queensland Softball Association and Softball Australia.
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2) Overview

In order to secure your team's place in the 2014 Pan Pacific Masters Games Softball competition team organisers must:

- i) Select team division
- ii) Create a team name and code
- iii) Register and pay for a minimum of six (6) players in one payment.

Registrations will open on **Wednesday 3 May** at www.mastersgames.com.au.

This process has been implemented as it ensures that only genuine teams are nominated which will assist with event planning and ultimately make your entire Games experience better.

3) Securing your team's position

Once you have decided that you would like to enter a team in the Pan Pacific Masters Games your first job is to drum up some interest from your fellow players and organise the minimum number of players so that you can secure a place in the competition for your team. You will then need to collect payment and some personal and contact details from each player.

Please note that to secure your team's place in the Games you must register a minimum of 6 *players* when you create the team. If the team organiser is also a player then they will be included within the minimum 6 players. However, if the team organiser is a Non-Playing Official they will not be included in the minimum and will therefore be required to register for one Non-Playing Official as well as 6 players (i.e. 7 people in total).

It will take some time to register this number of people and you will *not* be able to save and complete at a later time. In addition to plenty of time, you will also require a reliable computer and internet connection.

Registration Fees

There are two types of Fees:

1. *Games Fee* - Each participant is required to pay the Games Fee. Which fee depends on whether they are a player, non-playing official, or a supporter:

Entry Competitors: **\$100 per person**
Non-Playing Officials: **\$75 per person**
Supporters: **\$70 per person**

2. *Sport Fee* - Only players are required to pay the sport fee:

Softball Sport Fee: **\$95 per player per team**

Notes:

- i) A \$20 Late Fee will be incurred on the Competitor Games Fee for entries received after 3 September, 2014.
- ii) The Games Fee is only paid once by each person regardless of how many sports they enter.
- iii) The Competitor Games Fee is for anyone playing in a sport.
- iv) The Non-Playing Official Games Fee is team managers, umpires, scorers, coaches or officials who will not be playing but still want to be officially linked to the team and be eligible for a medal should the team place.
- v) The Supporter Games Fee is for family or friends who would like to attend the nightly entertainment.
- vi) You will only be able to create and manage teams if you are registered as a Competitor or Non-Playing Official.
- vii) Only Visa or MasterCard will be accepted for online registrations. American Express and Diners Club will not be accepted.

Please note you will require a credit card with a limit that covers the full amount required.

Team code creation

One of the steps when registering your team is to create a team code. The code is decided upon by the team manager. It is suggested to be 4-8 characters in length and should be a combination of letters and numbers. No two teams can have the same team code so it will be unique to your team. Once the team manager has registered the team (by selecting the team's division, created the team code and registering and paying for the minimum 6 players) they can then pass on the team code to any additional players or Non-Playing Officials so they can register as an individual in the team.
