2020 Pan Pacific Masters Games – Condition of Play

- All Games are permitted to have 2 trial ends, prior to designated starting time
- All Pairs and Fours Games are 14 ends or the bell at 2 hours 10 minutes duration
- All 2 Bowl Triples Games are 18 ends or the bell at 2 hours 10 minutes duration
- Dead Ends are to be replayed
- For time limited games – should the bell ring at the time limit, the end in play is **NOT** to be replayed
- Opponents for the first two games will be decided by blind draw prior to commencement of play
- The first 2 Games in each event will determine which section you will play in, for the Medal Rounds
- Medallists will be decided on results from the last three games, in each event, as follows

All Games:

- Most number of wins
 - If tied highest margin
 - If still tied countback of ends
- The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the conditions of play, because of weather conditions or any other reason deemed necessary. For example, games may be shortened or deleted if severe weather prevents play.
 - All Games will be governed by Bowls Australia Law.

Special Notes

- “Spare” names/teams are shown in some draws.....these positions are available firstly, to those Pan Pacific Masters Games bowls entrants not already entered in that particular event and who would like to play in more than their originally nominated events.
- All entry data was originally collated by Gold Coast Events Management who have overall responsibility for the organization of the Pan Pacific Masters Games. Southport Bowls Club has received that information in order to prepare draws and in some cases, arrange composite teams. Reliance has therefore been placed on the accuracy and completeness of the data supplied.
