Netball – Competition Rules

1. Games will be played in accordance with Official Rules of Netball (Revised 2020) (Umpires are to administer the game; SCNA Games Committee will administer the competition.)
2. Rolling Substitution are permitted. Unlimited substitutions permitted at any time during the game. Multiple substitutions can occur.
Procedure for this process to occur successfully must be followed, player substituting MUST stand at the end of their bench that is closest to the middle of the court, player MUST NOT leave this area until "tapped" by player coming off court, i.e., the one being substituted at NO point must ANY of these players interfere with the movement of the umpire. Penalty is a free pass where the ball was to the non-infringing team.
Players from the same team must be on court at ALL times-in the case of injury, procedure applying to this scenario will be followed according to the 2020 Rule Book
3. Players need to play 8 quarters to qualify for finals.
4. Injury time per 2020 Rule Book- 30 seconds maximum for injured player, for whom time was called for, must leave the court in the event of an injury, no extra time will be added to the game, but this also applies to the blood rule. For each subsequent stoppage for each team the injured or ill player must leave the court. A substitute may take the court. During the stoppage the coach or official may address the players.
5. The first named team in the draw are responsible for collecting the scorecard.
The winning team is responsible for returning the scorecard.
6. All players must sign the scorecard prior to taking the court, including all substitute players.
7. The Team Captains and Umpires must sign the scorecard at the end of the game.
8. The Scorecard must be completed in pen.
9. Each team must supply a scorer - scorers are asked to stand together courtside in a clear position for the umpires to observe. If you do not have an official scorer, you must accept the results of the scorer.
10. The score on the official scorecard will be recognised as the correct result.
11. All teams will be given a Game ball as a memento of their time at Southport Carrara Netball Association. These balls will be the accepted balls used during the competition.
12. Any team forfeiting throughout the playing week will also be forfeiting their right to play Finals games.
