



Lawn Bowls Competition Rules and Conditions of Play

Southport Bowls Club

Valid as at 21 September 2022

1. All Games are permitted to have two (2) trial ends, prior to designated starting time.
2. All Pairs Games are 2x2x2x2 games of 14 ends or the bell at 2 hours 10 minutes duration.
3. All Fours Games are of 14 ends or the bell at 2 hours 10 minutes duration.
4. All Triples Games are 2 Bowl Triples of 18 ends or the bell at 2 hours 10 minutes duration.
5. There will be NO Dead Ends – respot the Jack on the “T”.
6. For time limited games – should the bell ring at the time limit, the end in play is **NOT** to be replayed.
7. The first two (2) Games in each event will determine which section you will play in, for the Medal Rounds.
8. Medalists will be decided on results from the last three games, in each event, as follows :-
 - a. all Games.....most number of wins
 - b. if tied highest margin
 - c. if still tiedcountback of ends won
 - d. if still tiedthe least number of shots given away.
9. The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the conditions of play, because of weather conditions or any other reason deemed necessary.
10. All Games will be governed by Bowls Australia Law.
