

ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW



Our location: We are located at 125 Musgrave Avenue, Labrador QLD 4215

Fields of play:

Pitch 2 - Polytan Tokyo GT Pitch 1 - Poligras Platinum CoolPlus

Both fields are water based surfaces

Due to watering on Pitch 1 between matches there is to be no access across the field both prior to and at the end of every game. All teams must walk around Pitch 1 and not across it at any time. This also applies to officials. No equipment is to be dragged or carried across the pitch surface at any time. There is to be no food or drinks other than water to be taken onto the fields at any time. This includes any sports drinks at half time. Food and sports drinks can only be consumed in the dugouts. All teams are responsible for removing any rubbish and team items around team benches at the end of each game. This includes empty drink bottles, ice and food.

Recovery

There is no ice-bath recovery at the venue. Alternate recovery facilities are available in close proximity to the venue and may incur a charge such as:

Warm Up Location and Equipment

Teams are welcome to conduct their running warm-up on the surrounding grassed areas within the venue or external to the venue. Signage will be displayed should these become available due to wet weather conditions.

Teams are requested to do any 'on the ball' warm-up such as 'hitting and trapping' lengthways on the pitch rather than across to reduce the likelihood of injury. If teams commence hitting-up the wrong way, they may be requested to move.

Each team will be required to provide their own warm-up and training balls and other equipment throughout the tournament.



Venue Details

Food and Beverage Facilities

Canteen

There are canteen facilities on-site and operating on all game days throughout the tournament. The Canteen is located downstairs on ground level. It will open 1 hour prior to the first match and close at halftime of the last game. Lots of delicious canteen favorites are on offer.

Cafe

The cafe is located upstairs in the function room and will open one hour prior to the first game each day serving delicious barista coffee till 2pm. A self-serve coffee machine is also available after 2pm. There will be a selection of toasted sandwiches, banana bread, muffins and slices. Fresh sandwiches, soft drinks and water are also available.

Bar / Kitchen

The bar will be open after 10am each day. Alcohol can only be consumed in the bar area, or in the seats directly in front of the bar area. Alcohol can only be consumed downstairs at the venue within the concreted building footprint. Alcohol cannot be taken onto grassed areas at any time. The upstairs kitchen will open from 12 noon each day till after the end of the last game. Teams playing in the final games are welcome to pre order food so that it is ready at the end of your game. There are oven fresh pizzas, pasta, wedges and nachos available. Our menu is all about bringing people together with lots of share options available for teams.

Please note:

Alcohol is NOT to be bought into the venue at any time. The only exception to this is gifts between teams, but this cannot be consumed onsite.

Onsite Payments:

The Gold Coast Hockey Centre accepts EFTPOS payments only. All major credit and debit cards are accepted as well and card insert and swipe options. Payments can also be made with smart phones and smart watches.

Change Rooms and Team Benches

Teams will have access to the change rooms from the end of half time, until the start of their match, and can return at half time if they wish. Teams will have access post-match once the change rooms are clear until the beginning of halftime of the next match. Change Rooms will be labeled Pitch 1 - First Named / Second Named. Pitch 2 - First Named / Second Named.

First named and second named refers to the draw and if your team is named first or second on the draw. Team Managers to ensure security of their team's equipment and their belongings. All gear is to be taken when vacating a change room.



Team benches are located either side of the technical bench on Pitch 1 and Pitch 2 and include seating for interchange players and team support personnel.

Team benches will be allocated as follows:

First team listed on the draw utilise the bench to the left side of the technical bench when facing Pitch. Second team listed on the draw utilise the bench to the right side of technical bench when facing either Pitch

Team Managers to check and ensure all their team's equipment is removed from the team benches after each match.

Ice and Water

There will be water available for teams to use near the benches Injury ice will be provided on each bench for injuries.

Security

Change rooms will remain unlocked all day and all team equipment and valuable items should NOT be left in the change rooms at any time, unless supervised. The centre is locked every night, but no items of value should be left on site. The centre has a caretaker that lives on site and will respond to any security issues at night.

Parking

Please note there is limited public parking on site with 100 car spots available and overflow parking available along Musgrave Avenue. Teams are recommended to carpool to the venue.

Team Bus Parking

There is team bus parking available behind the caretaker's cottage and signs will be available to show access.

Disabled Access

All facilities have allocated disabled parking spots close to the entrance of the facilities. Ramp access is also available. There is a disability lift on site for access from the ground floor to the first floor.
