

Moto Racing – Event Schedule

This is a two-day fun event for off road motorcycles and riders. Vintage and modern machine categories are available on both days with motocross or enduro/vinduro machines equally suitable for both forms of racing.

Saturday November 2, 2024

Saturday will consist of a natural terrain motocross event for both vintage and modern machines. Motocross is an individual event i.e. no teams. The track is mild and will suit all classes of machine (motocross/ enduro/ vintage and modern) and riders of modest skill level and above.

Motocross: Sign on from 07:00, Scrutineering from 07:00 to 08:00, Riders' brief 08:00, Practice will start following riders briefing. Practice details to be advised on the day.

Racing starts approx. 09:00. Two rounds of racing to be held. Each moto is three laps with approx. 10 minutes between motos. Lap times approx. 2 minutes.

Each moto is limited to 15 riders only due to track limitations.

Motos will be run per class. Classes will be "all powers" as per event divisions described below i.e. all machine engine sizes compete against each other in any class.

Some classes may require several motos depending on the number of entries in that class. Riders will be assigned to their motos based on entries received with age groups and classes being combined where required to manage the program over the day.

Entries may need to be capped to limit the total number of motos per round in order to complete the race program by 4:00 pm. Your early entry will assist in securing a place in a moto.

Sunday November 3, 2024

Sunday will consist of an off-road pony express style event for both vintage (vinduro) and modern (enduro) machines with riders racing through a variety of bush and farmland in a teams based event. One team rider is on the course at any one time with riders handing over to the next team member in the change over area.

Vinduro: Sign on from 06:30, Scrutineering from 06:30 to 07:30, Riders' brief 07:30, Sighting lap 07:45 (track open for 5 minutes only) Racing starts as soon as the sight lap is clear of all riders at approx. 08:15. Race duration approx. 3 hours.

Enduro (Modern): Sign on from 09:30, scrutineering from 09:30 – 10:30, Riders brief 11:30, Sighting lap 11:45 (track open for 5 minutes only), Racing starts12:15 for approx. 3.5 hours
