#### **RISK MANAGEMENT**

Surfers Paradise Baseball Club has a fully documented Risk Management plan. All the relative compliance policies/remedies are in place to deal with identified risks and incidents associated with sporting clubs and events. This document is available from the Games Directors for further information, if required. However, for early awareness and reference the following for all visitors to the club during Pan Pacific Masters Games.

## **Evacuation Procedure-Emergency Response Plan.**

In the event of the possibility of an explosion or a bomb threat, all members and visitors are to follow the directives of the Games director/ duty officer or the club management of the day. All patrons are to leave the vicinity of the club, via the nearest exit, and proceed to follow the footpath in an easterly direction towards the Benowa Tavern. Continuing along the footpath, all patrons are to gather in the Car Park at the end of Showcase Court, Benowa, for further instructions.

# Liquor Licensing- Requirements.

SPBC is a licensed venue for this event, and we ask that you strictly adhere to the licensing regulations for the duration of the Games. Alcohol may only be consumed in the designated areas and **no alcohol**, **coolers/esky's** and in particular **no glass containers** are permitted to be brought into the grounds.
